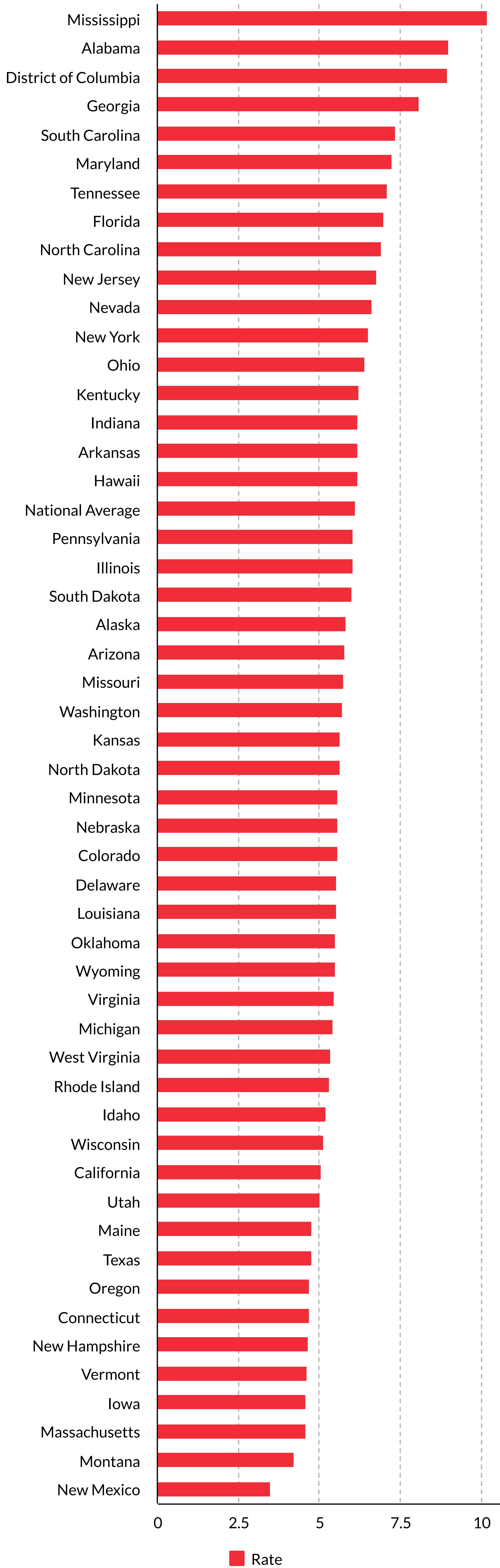


U.S. Stillbirth Data

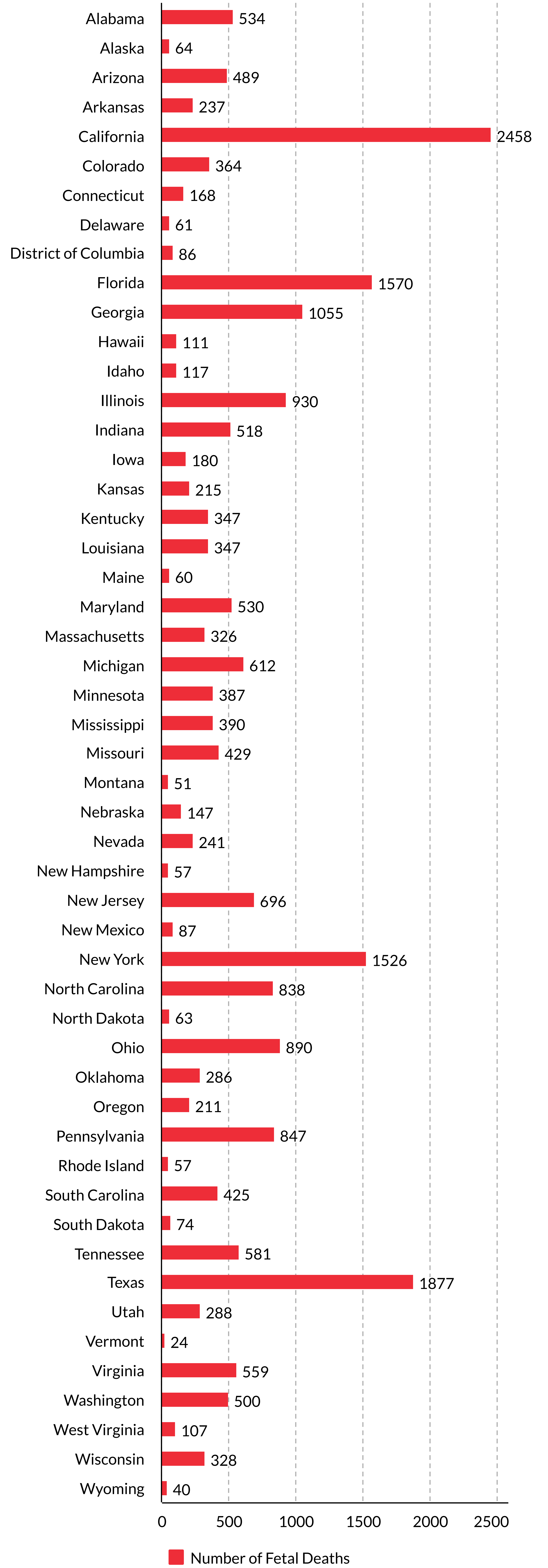

Fetal death, or stillbirth, is defined as the death or loss of a baby at or after 20 weeks of pregnancy or during delivery.

According to CDC Wonder, America lost an average of 23,384 babies a year to stillbirth during 2014-2018.

We lose more babies to stillbirth than infant mortality.

Racial disparities persist.

For Black women, one out of every 96 pregnancies will end in stillbirth.
