Baby Save: Meet Ryen

"One night when I was 37 weeks and 2 days pregnant, at around 7 p.m., I was trying to do another recording of Ryen's kicks when I noticed a dramatic decrease in movement. She was typically so active in the evenings and I really started to worry after 2 hours had passed and I still had not felt a single kick.

I quickly got into my car and visited my local maternity unit where they assured me that my baby's heartbeat was within normal limits, but found that my blood pressure was abnormally high and I was already 4 centimeters dilated. My water had broken and I didn't even know it!

They admitted me into the hospital that night and the next day my husband and I had our beautiful daughter at 6:12 p.m.! And to our surprise, there was no cord around her neck and she was an extremely healthy baby.

Without the *Count the Kicks* app I would have never noticed the decrease in movement and went in to have my beautiful and healthy baby the next day! I am grateful that my doctor not only had the *Count the Kicks* posters and brochures at his office, but also that he encouraged me to utilize the free app, as prior to that I was only an occasional app user.

Being in tune with Ryen's daily movement patterns and having a doctor who educated and encouraged me was vital to the delivery of our healthy daughter." -Morgan S., Ryen's mom



We published 15 new Baby Save stories in 2022, and have shared 2 so far in 2023.

Since Count the Kicks began, we have heard from more than 110 families in 33 states and 5 countries who reached out to share how our program helped their baby arrive safely.

Key Moments

In September we attended the ISA conference in Utah. Dr. Alexander Heazell presented findings of research on *Count the Kicks* and CEO Emily Price presented on our advocacy work.

Program Director Megan Aucutt, Arizona Ambassador Shawn Soumilas, Idaho Ambassador Lindsay Rager, CEO Emily Price and Idaho Ambassador Angelica Kovach attended on our behalf to learn about the latest research on stillbirth prevention and share our prevention work with others.

In April we published a Stillbirth in the U.S. Report on the connection between stillbirth and maternal mortality + morbidity.

Key Moments

Founder Janet Petersen, CEO Emily Price, and Minnesota Ambassador Amanda Duffy were featured in an article by ProPublica reporter Duaa Eldeib that discussed how stillbirth and stillbirth prevention have often been largely ignored in the U.S. Her Child Was Stillborn at 39
Weeks. She Blames a System That
Doesn't Always Listen to Mothers.

Every year more than 20,000 pregnancies in the U.S. result in a stillbirth, but not all of these tragedies were inevitable. As many as one in four stillbirths are potentially preventable.

We stepped up our advocacy efforts in 2022, and were proud to be the primary stakeholder of the Maternal and Child Health Stillbirth Prevention Act, which was introduced in Congress in March. We made three visits to Washington, D.C. to meet with key Capitol Hill staff and members of Congress. We also helped author the "National Stillbirth Prevention Day" resolution, which took place on Sept. 19, 2022. More than 3,500 people took action on our advocacy platform and showed their support for stillbirth prevention legislation.

Our Programmatic Work



We hosted virtual baby showers in South Carolina, Nevada and Florida, and an inperson baby shower in Des Moines, Iowa. Together these showers reached more than 1,300 expectant parents! We already know of one baby saved in South Carolina!



We hosted three national webinars in 2022! One was held in April during Black Maternal Health Week, one was during Black Maternal Mental Health Month in July, and we hosted a webinar in Spanish in September during Hispanic Heritage Month.



Volunteers helped assemble nearly 1,500 toolkits for providers in 7 expansion states. This includes 750 Delta Dental toolkits that were mailed throughout Iowa. We also expanded our oral health and pregnancy program to Alabama!










We have returned to in-person conferences and baby fairs!

Fundraising to Save Babies

The 2022 Every Woman Counts Luncheon, presented by MercyOne, was our first-ever hybrid event, with more than 1,000 people in the ballroom and hundreds more online from around the country. Together we raised a record \$223,000 to save babies.







Since the launch of Every Kick Counts, presented by UnityPoint, on Super Bowl Sunday 2022, more than 100 athletes signed on to raise awareness and funds to support *Count the Kicks*. These athletes represent high school, college and professional teams from over 30 different states. Together they have raised over \$115,000 in lifesaving funds to support stillbirth prevention.

2022 Fundraising Impact

GivingTuesday- Our "Together We Count" campaign raised a record-setting \$20,000+ to support our work.

End of Year- Our end-of-year campaign raised more than \$23,000 to help fund our new office space in 2023.

Iowa Partners at the Heart of National Expansion

Since 2016, our organization has been working to expand our proven *Count the Kicks* stillbirth prevention program beyond Iowa. As 2023 begins, we are thrilled to be able to provide FREE *Count the Kicks* educational materials to providers and expectant parents in 25 states. (HALF the country!)

We are proud to call lowa home, and to partner with many lowa-based businesses and organizations. These partnerships have helped to fuel the national expansion of our evidence-based public health campaign. We would like to thank these partners for their support in expanding our mission to make kick counting a common practice for all expectant parents in the third trimester of pregnancy.

Strategic America: Since first helping to develop and design our printed educational materials in 2007-2008, West Des Moines based <u>Strategic America</u> has continued to support our work by providing in-kind design and marketing services for *Count the Kicks*, and the Every Kick Counts campaign, which they helped us launch in 2022.

Strategic Imaging: This Waterloobased <u>company</u> helps us print and distribute our printed educational materials across the U.S. In 2022 they helped fulfill a record number of orders (more than 2,200 orders and 850,000+ pieces).
