How to Participate:

Step 1: Choose Your Landmark

Identify a building or bridge in your community that you'd like to request for illumination. Here are a few tips:

- Use Google or city of commerce websites to find contact details.
- Reach out as soon as possible.
- In smaller towns, City Halls may be willing to accommodate your request.
- If possible, request teal and/or purple lighting.

Step 2: Notify Us

Once your request is confirmed, fill out <u>this quick form</u> to let us know. This helps us share your efforts and spread the word about the collective efforts of stillbirth prevention advocates around the country!

Step 3: Host a Community Event (Optional)

Consider organizing a gathering outside the illuminated landmark. This could include a group photo and a brief remembrance ceremony. Consider contacting local media to broaden the impact of your event. Media coverage is a powerful way to raise awareness about National Stillbirth Prevention Day.
